BRUCE SPRINGSTEEN

Bruce Springsteen and The E Street Band's 2023 European tour sold over 1.6 million tickets and earned widespread praise as some of the best shows of the band's career. They'll make a triumphant return to Europe in 2024 with a 22-show stadium run including Croke Park Stadium on **May 19th**.



AC/DC

Coldplay, as part of their record-breaking 'Music of The Spheres' World Tour will play Croke Park Stadium on Thursday 29th, Friday 30th August, Sunday 1st September and Monday 2nd September 2024.

JOIN THE CROKE PARK COMMUNITY TEAM

RESIDENTS 2024 CAR PARKING PASSES

The 2024 local resident pass, for households inside the Croke Park Garda event day cordon, is available for collection from **Fitzgibbon Street Garda Station**. The station is open from **8am to 9pm** daily.

To collect your pass, please bring the following with you to the station:

- Proof of identification
- Proof of address (a recent utility bill)
- Your old 2022/2023 resident pass

The Gardaí have advised that there will be a limit of 3 passes per household, except in exceptional circumstances. Any household needing more than 3 passes should contact the garda special events team in Fitzgibbon Street station on 01 666 8463. Local businesses requiring more than 3 passes are also asked to contact the Garda events team regarding their specific needs.



CROKE PARK COMMUNITY FUND 2024 - APRIL FUNDING ROUND
