Rules of the Competition:

- 1 Awards are confined to young people between 13 and 21 years of age
- 2 Permanent residence of the young person must be in the Dublin North Central Garda area
- 3 Awards are confined to individuals and groups of two or more young people
- 4 Judges decision is final
- 5 Any member of the public including Gardaí may nominate anyone whom they feel deserves an award
- 6 Nominations may come from family members or relatives
- 7 Forms must be signed by nominator/co-nominator
