## NEW COMMUNITY DATABASE - SIGN UP TODAY

We're launching a new community database next year. You may have registered with the stadium before, but we need you to sign up again & let us know that you want to stay on our database for ticket draws & for us to contact you about event day news & updates on other community events & activities.

Fill in this form to let us know you want to keep in touch - if we don't hear from you by Friday, 31 January 2020, you will no longer hear from us and you won't be included in future local resident ticket draws.

To be fair to all households, only 1 member per household can register as the primary householder & be included in the stadium's ticket database & our community text scheme. Up to 3 other members of a household can now also register to receive email updates from us on event day information & community initiatives.

#### **Data Protection Notice**

The following information is being provided to you as outlined in the General Data Protection Regulation. It is intended to inform you of how the Personal Information provided on this form will be used, by whom and for what purposes. #### Who is the Data Controller?

Croke Park is the Data Controller of the Personal Data contained on this form.

#### What is the purpose of processing my Personal Data?

The purpose for processing your Personal Data is to facilitate your request to be placed on the Croke Park Community Database in order to inform you of exclusive local residents' ticket draws, pre-sales and local community information such as traffic restrictions on Croke Park event days.

#### Who will have access to my Personal Data?

Your Personal Data can be accessed by the Croke Park Community team in order to facilitate your above request.

#### Where is your Personal Data stored?

Your data will be stored in Croke Park Stadium for the duration of your involvement with the Community Database.

#### How long will your Personal Data be stored for?

Your Personal Data will be held for the duration of your involvement with the Community Database. Due to the nature of the Community Database, we will not delete your information unless one of the following occurs:

- You have contacted us and requested us to delete your information from the Database.
- A new individual has registered appropriately at your address and you are no longer the primary householder.

## Will my name be published if I win tickets through the Community Database?

In order to respect the privacy of our neighbours, if you win tickets through the Community Database, your name will not be published. However, your name will be available to our auditors in order to comply with our obligations to ensure all ticket draws are conducted fairly and in a transparent manner.

#### I would like a copy of my Personal Data - how can I obtain this?

You have the right to request a copy of all your Personal Data and can do so by contacting us. This information will be provided to you within one month and will be provided free of charge.

#### What are my privacy rights relating to my Personal Data?

You have the right to have your Personal Data updated, rectified, or deleted if you so wish. You can do so by contacting us.

#### Where can I get further information?

Further information regarding your rights can be obtained through the Data Protection Commission, Canal House, Station Road, Portarlington, Co. Laois, or on the website www.dataprotection.ie

#### How do I make a complaint or report a breach?

Should you wish tto make a complaint or report a breach in relation to your Personal Data, you can do so by using one of the webforms on the Data Protection Commission's website at www.dataprotection.ie.
